Reading – Read words with common suffixes

- Make simple predictions
- Read contractions and understand purpose

Writing – Use common prefixes and suffixes

- Form upper and lower case letters correctly.

Grammar – Use common plural and verb suffixes

Test types – Write a recount

- Performance poetry
- Write captions
- Instructions
- Stories from other cultures



Numeracy

- Number and place value – counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Fractions: $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$
- Addition and subtraction using 1 and 2 digit numbers
- Multiplication – solving word problems using doubles and arrays
- Division – solving word problems using grouping and sharing
- Measurement – lengths, heights, capacity, volume and weight
- Position and direction using turns
- Recognise and add coins



Science

- Match animals to their offspring
- Animal life cycles
- To understand that there are more hours of daylight in spring and summer
- To understand the position of the sun in the sky at sunrise
- How to be safe in the sun
