

Dear Parents and Children,

Our trip to France is fast approaching. Please find attached a kit list, documents list and medical form. Please bring the completed documents to school by the dates specified on the attached lists.

Kit and Documents List

Please make sure you check you have everything included in the kit list. If you lose the letter, it will be available on the school website shortly in the Forms and Letters Archive.

Labelling Clothes

Bearing in mind we will be visiting lots of places and mixing with many children at school, it would be very helpful if all items of clothing were labelled with your child's name, especially, hoodies and cardigans. The child's surname written in permanent pen on the label is adequate.

Futuroscope

Our French school will reserve translation headsets for us. Every child will need a set of earphones. Please bring a cheap pair. If you do not have any they will be available to buy at Futuroscope for approx. two euros.

Luggage labels

Please label your child's suitcase and back pack using the labels which will be provided by school on the morning of departure, prior to loading the coach. Please do not write your child's name or home address. We will issue the children's labels with their initials. Also please put a copy of the addresses provided, inside each of their bags whilst packing, in case their luggage labels fall off.

Departure Time

We will be departing Wanborough Primary School on **Sunday 10th June** at 6:45 am at the latest. Please ensure you are at school by **6:30am** to give us time to load the coach. Members of staff will be at school from 6.20am. Please remember our neighbours at school will probably be enjoying their sleep at this time.

Blog / Communications

Our intention is to send progress reports, particularly when we are travelling, using the school Twitter feed, @WPrimary. This can be accessed from the website home page. We may also set up a blog, which will be linked from the website. We plan that the children will be able to contribute to this, to give you a taste of our adventures 'as they happen'. However, (unlike PGL), the children will not have access to an ICT suite, so it is unlikely that they will see any messages or comments that you might post.



If there are any significant changes of plan, particularly delays to our return, we will use the text system. All these communication plans are, of course, subject to availability of phone signal and/or WIFI.

Journey Home

We will leave the St Cyr residential centre at 9.00am on Friday 15th June then depart Lille at 15:35, arriving at London St. Pancras at 16:05. We anticipate arriving back at Wanborough Primary School by approx. 7:15pm. Text notifications of delays etc. may come from Mr Woodman's mobile number stated below rather than the school texts.
