



Co-production Week 2024

Monday 1st July marks the start of Co-production Week 2024. Co-production is about professionals working in equal partnership with people using services: young people, parents, carers and families. Co-production offers people choice, control and the chance to be fully involved in transforming education, social care and health provision. Children, young people and families know their needs the best, so they should be at the centre of decision making to help develop and shape the services that support them.

At Swindon Borough Council we aim to empower children, young people and families to take part in making choices about their own lives. We want them to have an impact on how services that support them are developed.

The Swindon's Children and Young People's Participation Strategy 2021–2024 outlines what children, young people and families should expect from us in order to achieve this:

- They should be involved in choices that affect them.
- They will be supported and encouraged to say when they are not happy.
- They will be supported and encouraged to tell us when things are going well.
- Their voice will make a difference and we will take their views seriously.
- They will be able supported and encouraged to give their feedback and suggestions.
