





There are a number of cycling sessions for SEND children and their families available during these summer holidays.

#### **Bi-Weekly Cycling Sessions for SEND Children**

Where: Moredon Sporting Hub (MSH)

When: From Thursday 25th July. These sessions will run every Monday & Thursday until Monday 2nd September.

Time: Between 12:00 - 13:00.

Cost: £3.00 per child per session (there is no charge for accompanying parents/carers).

How to sign up: Booking is required for these sessions, for the first week please book your child's place by emailing

Parents/carers need to complete a <u>Participant Registration form</u> & <u>Disclaimer</u> before joining, this can be completed online or on arrival at reception.

There will be a number of adapted cycles as well as standard bicycles & helmets to borrow as part of this session. Families are welcome to bring their own cycles to the session if they have them.

#### **Family Disability Cycling sessions**

Where: A traffic-free track yet to be confirmed.

When: Weekly sessions from Friday 16th August, also to be confirmed.

What: Sessions for disabled adults/children to come and borrow a bike and cycle around a cycle track with their family/friends. The aim is to switch these sessions to a weekend day once the school term begins again.

#### **Kid's Learn to Cycle & Cycle Confidence Sessions**

Some learn to cycle and cycle confidence sessions are being organised for children in these summer holidays. The organiser is keen to ensure that these sessions are as inclusive as possible to neurodiverse children and those with additional needs. Separate dedicated sessions can be provided if this is required as well. If you know a child who is interested in joining the sessions, please encourage their parents/carers to get in touch to let the organiser know if there are any adaptations that can be made to break down the barriers to joining such sessions.

# Swindon Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF)

Since 2018, the government's holiday activities and food program has given support to children getting free school meals during school holidays. After successful trials between 2018 and 2020, the program was available in all upper tier local authorities in 2021.

Research has shown that school holidays can be a hard time for some families. For some children this can lead to a holiday experience gap. Children from low-income families are:

- · Less likely to join organised activities outside of school
- More likely to have 'unhealthy holidays' in terms of nutrition and physical health
- · More likely to feel socially isolated





#### **HAF** aims to

As a result of Swindon's Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF) we want children who attend to:

- Eat healthy food over the school holidays.
- · Be active during the school holidays.
- Take part in fun and enriching activities. These activities help the development of resilience, character and wellbeing. As well as their wider educational success.
- Be safe and not socially isolated.
- Have more knowledge of health and nutrition.
- Be more engaged with school and other local services.
- We also want to make sure that the families who take part in this programme:
- Develop their understanding of nutrition and food budgeting. Food budgeting means planning meals and shopping to spend an affordable amount on food.
- Get information and support pointed towards them, for example, health, employment, and education.
