

Dear Parents

I am writing to inform you of recent staffing appointments and decisions the Governors and myself have made at school in response to the departure of Mrs Wood, Mrs Allen and Mrs Killick.

Firstly, I'm delighted to announce that Miss Watts and Miss Brant will from September become Acting Assistant Heads. Whilst both continuing as Class Teachers and Core Subject Leads they will join me in continuing to move the school forward in all areas.

Secondly, we appointed on Friday Mrs Lauren Hyatt who will be joining our teaching team for 2018/19. She will be working in tandem with Mrs Wride who will be returning after her maternity leave.

With Mrs Killick leaving at the end of this week there have been some changes to the support in some classes. From next week Miss Cullen will be working in Year 1 alongside Mr Day and Mrs Allnutt. Mrs Hingley will be working in Year 3 with Miss Corbyn with Mrs Allnutt spending time daily in Year 2 with Miss Watts until the end of the academic year.

We are hoping to inform you of next year's classes after I return from France in preparation for the transition days at the end of the month. Whilst I am away with Year 6 Mrs Wood should be contacted if you have a matter which requires significant attention. Alternatively, I will have access to e-mails in the evenings and will be in contact with the school office on a daily basis.

With regards to France – both Miss Hughes and Mr Day will be completing their French immersion courses during the week beginning July 2nd. The funding we received from The British Council has seen eight members of staff receive training in the delivery of French which we hope will have an impact on the teaching of our chosen language across the school. Cover arrangements for these classes will be communicated in due course.

Finally, there is a big congratulations for Miss Hughes who got married over the weekend and is now Mrs Hayden – I'm sure you will all join in with us wishing her and Mr Hayden every success and happiness.
