

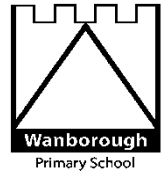

Interview a family member or friend about their stories of WW2 - they do not have to have been in it but they might know someone who was. Share your findings with the class.

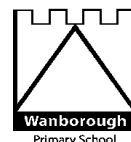
Remembrance
